The organization began in October of 2008 and we have already shipped over 1,000 bracelets. So, our hands are busy here preparing the bracelets and meanwhile, God is sending his chosen few out to the mission field prepared to give gifts about the gospel story. It has been rewarding and I do believe that God has a purpose for each bracelet made. This is an exciting time for us! I praise the Lord for the opportunity!"

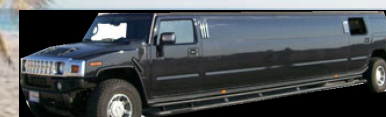
