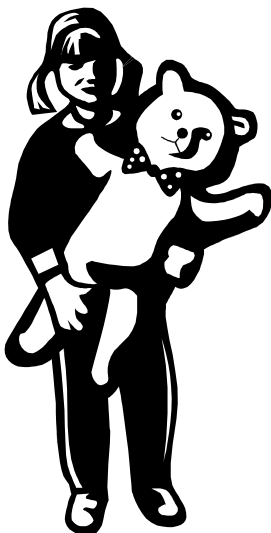

Randolph Hospital Hosts 12th Annual Teddy Bear Fair

Visiting the hospital can be a very frightening experience for anyone, especially children. That's why for the 12th year in a row, Randolph Hospital has offered its famous "Teddy Bear Fair" to students throughout Randolph County. During the week of March 9th- 13th, more than 1,500 second graders from 21 different schools will visit Randolph Hospital for the annual Teddy Bear Fair. During the fair, nurses will perform mock procedures on "hurt" teddies to teach children that the hospital is a friendly and helping place. The fair is specifically designed to help reduce children's fears of visiting a hospital and having routine medical procedures performed. There is more to the fair than just teaching children why not to fear the hospital; these young students also get a glimpse of the many healthcare careers available at Randolph Hospital. "We're excited about this year's event and look forward to the children visiting the hospital," says Deana Thomas, director of Education at Randolph Hospital. "It's important for children to know that the hospital isn't a scary place. The goal of this program is reduce the fear and anxiety in children in case they should have to come to the hospital." This year's event will consist of six stations -

handwashing, cardiopulmonary, diagnostic imaging, emergency room procedures and nutrition and exercise. In addition, a special station will include having "teddy bear blood" drawn for a laboratory test. "The Teddy Bear Fair is a unique program and a great community service," says Dremia Meier, board/community relations director for Randolph County Schools. "The program is helpful to parents and teachers as well as students. It allows children to learn how to better handle emergency situations." In addition to visiting the stations, students attending the fair will receive a goody bag containing various health related handouts that are appropriate for their grade level. "We believe this is an important event for the students," says Carla Freemyer, Public Information Officer at Asheboro City Schools. "After seeing how well the bears are cared for by the smiling nurses, the students feel more comforted about visiting the hospital."

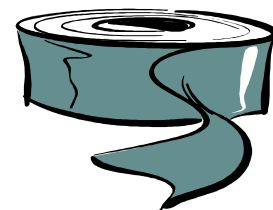
